NBN Co releases first map of rollout site in Penrith

NBN Co have now released a fibre map outlining the area for the start of construction of the National Broadband Network in Penrith.

Federal Member for Lindsay, David Bradbury, today joined representatives from the Penrith Business Alliance, including Chairman Paul Brennan and representatives from local businesses to welcome this announcement.

"This is fantastic news for our community. Thousands of local businesses and households will soon have access to high speed, affordable broadband," Mr Bradbury said.

"Penrith will be one of the first locations in Australia to commence construction of the NBN.

"Investment in the NBN will help Australia become an innovative knowledge-based economy of the future.

"Once delivered the NBN will ensure every home, school, hospital and business will have access to affordable, high-speed broadband.

"The rollout will begin in Penrith CBD, providing local businesses with a range of new opportunities to innovate, expand and increase efficiency."

NBN Co recently announced that 17,800 premises in the Penrith area are scheduled to see the start of construction in the next 12 months.

The rollout will be conducted through a series of modules. The fibre map released today outlines the first stage of construction which will begin in Penrith CBD (map attached). The module will cover around 3000 premises and is scheduled to be completed in around 12 months.

The NBN will provide access to high-speed broadband to 100% of Australian premises, including schools, hospitals and businesses and will change the way we access information and communicate with each other.
