1. Building the Education Revolution - Primary Schools for the 21st Century, Round Two

More than \$46 million is to be shared between 19 local schools under the second round of the Rudd Government's Primary Schools for the 21st Century (P21) program.

P21 is part of the largest school modernisation program in Australia's history. Under the P21 program, every primary school will be eligible for up to \$3 million to build halls, libraries and multi-purpose facilities.

P21 is investing in school infrastructure for the future and supporting local jobs.

More local schools will receive funding in subsequent rounds.

2. Building the Education Revolution - National School Pride Program, Round Two

Local schools will also be sharing in more than \$3 million in funding for maintenance under the National School Pride Program.

Every school in Australia will receive up to \$200,000 for maintenance and minor building works, helping to revitalise schools and support jobs.

3. Better TAFE Facilities

The Rudd Government is investing in TAFE education infrastructure to help support local jobs and improve facilities for TAFE students.

TAFE colleges around Australia received funding from the \$200 million Better TAFE Facilities fund to improve buildings and learning areas.

TAFE campuses at Penrith and Kingswood will share in almost \$1.4 million for refurbishments and maintenance.

4. Insulation Installation

Eligible ceiling insulation installers are now invited to register on the Installer Provider Register.

The insulation installation program begins in full from 1 July 2009. From this date, eligible householders will need to select an installer from the Government's Installer Provider Register to install their insulation as part of the package. They are free to use any installer listed on the register.
